Responsibilities / Activities

- Follow the camp policies and procedures
- Assist in the and promotion of program schedules
- Responsible to support and actively participate in camp activities
- Provide direct delivery for specific programs
- Attend staff training provided by Camp Manager
- Actively participate in staff meetings
- Develop professional engaging relationships with all campers
- Complete inventory of program material and provide manager with list of materials needed during pre-camp and at the end of each session
- Ensure Program area is maintained and cleaned on a regular basis
- Performs other related duties as required.
